

EVALUATION OF THE PERFORMANCE

OF MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY MEMBERS FOR
THE PERIOD MAY 2023 – FEBRUARY 2024

Prizren/Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane,
Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo,
Istog/Istok and Klokot/Kllokot



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Purpose

Enhancing accountability and promoting a better performance of the municipal assembly members in their representative, legislative and oversight role.

Methodology

In order to evaluate the performance of municipal assembly members, we carried out a hybrid monitoring of the activities, namely a direct (in-person) monitoring of the municipal assembly sessions, and monitoring of the budget hearings organized by the executive and legislative of assemblies, as well as online monitoring of the members activities outside the municipal assembly sessions. The municipal assembly members have been evaluated against nine (9) indicators, divided into three (3) evaluation categories: a) representative role b) legislative/legislator role, and c) oversight role.

In the representative role, the municipal assembly members have been evaluated against four (4) indicators:

- #1.1. The number of meetings organized by municipal assembly members with representatives of local councils and citizens (including marginalized groups) to discuss issues that are of interest to the community;
- #1.2. The percentage of participants belonging to marginalized groups in the meetings organized by the municipal assembly members (according to Indicator 1.1);
- #1.3. The number of issues/requests raised by municipal assembly members in municipal assembly sessions or have addressed to the executive, and which derive from in-person meetings with citizens or from the interaction of the municipal assembly members with citizens via social networks;
- #1.4. The percentage of issues/requests related to the interests of marginalized groups that were raised in the assembly session or addressed to the executive.

In the legislative/legislator role, the municipal assembly members have been evaluated against three (3) indicators:

- #2.1. The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by the municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to the meetings with citizens;
- #2.2. The number of legal initiatives (proposals for municipal regulations, amendments to regulations, decisions, municipal budget) raised by municipal assembly members during the sessions;

#2.3. The number of proposals put forward by municipal assembly members during the budget hearings for MTBF and the annual budget of the municipality, both in the hearings organized by the executive and those organized by the legislative of the municipality.

In the oversight role, the municipal assembly members have been evaluated against two (2) indicators:

#3.1. The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed by municipal assembly members to the executive members;

#3.2. The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation.

The performance of members was evaluated for the period May 2023 - February 2024 and the assembly members of the municipalities: Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane, Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo, Istog/Istok and Klokot/Klllokot, were subject to evaluation.

The evaluation included scores and the maximum scores for all indicators were 100. The chairpersons of the municipal assemblies, the deputy chairperson of the Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren among the communities, as well as the heads of groups of political entities, have not been subject to performance evaluation, with the exception of the Municipal Assembly of Klokot/Klllokot, where only the chairperson of the assembly was excluded from the evaluation.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren/Prizren

The Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren has 41 members. The opposition in the Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren has 29 members (11 LVV, 6 LDK, 3 AAK, 1 VAKAT, 2 KDTP, 1 NDS, 1 SDU and 4 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS)¹, whereas the position has 12 members (9 PDK, 2 NISMA and 1 YTHP). Out of the 41 members of the Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren, six (6) are not subject to the evaluation based on the performance evaluation methodology, including four (4) heads of parliamentary groups (PDK, LVV, LDK and AAK), the chairperson of the municipal assembly and the chairperson of the assembly among the communities.

In terms of gender representation, 14 women members (F) have shown a positive performance (1 AAK, 2 from LDK, 4 LVV, 4 PDK, with 1 from KDTP, NISMA and INDEPENDENT MEMBER), whereas 21 men members of the Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren (M) have shown a positive performance (6 from LVV, 3 from PDK, 3 from LDK, 3 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS, 1 from AAK and 1 from VAKAT, YTHP, SDU, NDS and NISMA). None of the assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren, who were subject to the performance evaluation during the period May 2023 - February 2024, has scored zero points due to the fact that all assembly members have been committed in at least one of the evaluation indicators during this period.

24 members from the opposition in the Municipal Assembly of Prizren were subject to the performance evaluation (LVV, LDK, VAKAT, KDTP, NDS and 4 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS),² while the position has 11 members who are subject to performance evaluation (PDK, NISMA, SDU, and YTHP). Out of 24 members of the opposition, all have shown commitment/performed (9 F and 15 M). Even the 11 municipal assembly members among the position have shown commitment/performed in at least one indicator (5 F and 6 M) during the evaluation period.

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 35 members have scored positive results in the evaluation indicators. Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) is the member with the best performance during this period with 65 points, Ilir Gashi (LVV) with 55 points and Dafina Alishani (LVV) with 50 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

- 1 Officially, these political entities do not have a coalition with the ruling party, while Kujtesa Kabashi-Shatri won the mandate through the LDK political entity, but declared herself independent; Bujar Hasani and Kastriot Krasniqi have declared themselves as independent, but they won the mandate through the political entity PDK, as well as Petrit Hoxhaj has declared as independent, but he won the mandate through the LVV.
- 2 Officially, these political entities do not have a coalition with the ruling party.

The members with the poorest performance during this period are: Agnesa Sinanaj - Gavazaj (AAK), Brikena Karavidaj (LDK), Shkelzen Kastrati (PDK). These are the members who during this period scored only 2 points each out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The women members (F) with the best performance during this period are: Dafina Alishani (LVV) with 50 points, Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) with 40 points and Ymran Fusha (PDK) with 35 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

From the point of view of the political entities representation, all assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren represented by different political entities have been positively evaluated and among them are ten (10) members from LVV, 7 from PDK, 5 from LDK, 2 from AAK, 2 NISMA, and one member from each of the following: KDTP, VAKAT, YTHP, SDU, NDS, as well as 4 independent members.

19 municipal assembly members took the office for the first time to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 6 women members (F) and 13 men members (M) won the mandate for the first time. Although all of these members have shown positive results in at least one of the evaluation indicators, there are six (6) members in this category who have performed better. Among these members who have performed better in this category are: Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) with 40 points, Selman Sokolaj (LVV) with 35 points, Ymran Fusha (PDK) with 35 points, Islam Thaqi (LVV) with 30 points, Marin Përgjoka (LDK) with 25 points and Sead Arifi (VAKAT) with 23 points.

As for classification by age, the Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren has 8 members in the 18-35 age group. Among them, all members have performed, whereas Dafina Alishani (LVV) is the member with the best performance in this age group with a total of 50 points, followed by Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) with 40 points and Marin Përgjoka (LDK) with a total of 25 points. In terms of gender in this age group, there are 4 women members (F) and 4 men members (M) who have performed.

The Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren has 19 members in the 36-50 age group. All assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren in this age group have shown commitment to perform and none of them has scored zero points. The municipal assembly member, Petrit Hoxhaj (independent member), has the best performance in this age group with a total of 65 points, followed by Selman Sokolaj (LVV) with 35 points. In terms of gender in this age group, 8 women members (F) and 11 men members (M) have performed.

The Assembly of the Municipality of Prizren has 8 members in the 51+ age group. All members of this age group have shown commitment/performed and none of them scored zero points. The municipal assembly member, Ilir Gashi (LVV), has the best performance in this age group with a total of 55 points, followed by Ymran Fusha (PDK) with 35 points, as well as Islam Thaqi (LVV) and Shukri Quni (NISMA) with 30 points each out of 100 points, which is the maximum score in all indicators. In terms of gender in this age group, 2 women members (F) and 6 men members (M) have performed.

Evaluation against indicators

As for the evaluation Indicator 1.1 ***“The number of meetings organized by municipal assembly members with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups,”*** during the evaluation period, three assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren have organized meetings with citizens. During this evaluation period, Ilir Gashi (LVV), Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) and Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) each have organized two (2) meetings with citizens.

As for the evaluation Indicator 1.2 ***“The number of participants in the organized meetings belonging to marginalized groups”***, Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) and Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK), are the only two members who scored each five (5) points in Indicator 1.2 due to the number of participation of marginalized groups in the meetings organized during the period May 2023 - February 2024. As for the commitment of position - opposition, two of these members come from the opposition (LVV and

Independent Member) and one (1) member who has organized meetings with citizens comes from the position (PDK).

Regarding Indicator 1.3, namely **“The number of issues/requests raised by municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions in social media,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, twelve (12) members have shown commitment/performed. Ten (10) members who have scored in this indicator come from the opposition (6 LVV, 2 LDK and 2 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS) and two (2) from the position (PDK). In terms of gender, six (6) women members (F) and five (5) men members (M) have performed in this indicator. The largest number of issues/requests in this indicator was raised by Ilir Gashi (LVV) with a total of 7 issues/requests and scored 10 points, which is the maximum score in this indicator. Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) and Nazife Kokollari (LVV) have each raised two (2) issues/requests in this indicator and the other members Dafina Alishani (LVV), Islam Thaci (LVV), Selman Sokolaj (LVV), Faruk Tahiri (LVV), Naxhije Memaj (LDK), Qemajl Krasniqi (LDK), Dafina Billaca (PDK), Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) and Kujtesa Kabashi – Shatri (Independent Member) are the members who raised each one (1) issue or request and as a result of this scored five (5) points each. On the other hand, a total of 23 assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 1.4, namely **“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of Marginalized Groups that were raised in the assembly session”**, four (4) members scored a positive result during this period. Dafina Alishani (LVV) with 5 points, Islam Thaci (LVV) with 5 points, Egzona Hoxhaj (PDK) with 5 points and Naxhije Memaj (LDK) with 5 points, three among the opposition and one among the position. On the other hand, a total of 31 assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely **“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 to February 2024, three (3) municipal assembly members raised no issues and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Nazife Kokollari (LVV), Kastriot Krasniqi (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) and Driton Daçi (PDK), are the members who have raised no issues or requests during this evaluation period and scored zero (0) points in this indicator.

On the other hand, 32 assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren have raised issues or requests during the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among the 32 members who have performed, 22 of them are among the opposition (9 LVV, 5 LDK, 2 AAK, 1 KDTP, 1 VAKAT, 1 NDS and 3 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS) and 10 among the position (6 PDK, 2 NISMA, 1 SDU and 1 YTHP). In terms of gender, 13 women members (F) and 19 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, 13 municipal assembly members scored five (5) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period. While the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Ilir Gashi (LVV) with a total of 21 issues raised, Dafina Alishani (LVV) with a total of 18 issues raised and Ymran Fusha (PDK) with a total of 15 issues raised. In total, 224 different issues were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren during this evaluation period, while such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 2.2, namely **“The number of legislative initiatives (municipal regulations, proposals for amending regulations, budget) proposed by municipal assembly members during the assembly session,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, Ilir Gashi (LVV) has proposed four (4) legal initiatives, Dafina Alishani (LVV) was the member who proposed three (3) legal initiatives, Marin Përgjoka (LDK), Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER), Agim Muçaj (AAK) and Ertan Simitci (YTHP) have each proposed one (1) legal initiative.

Regarding Indicator 2.3, namely **“The number of proposals during the development of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality organized by the executive and the legislative,”** during the monitoring of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality, 26 members have put forward no proposals for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization

of budget hearings. Nine (9) members have been evaluated positively in this indicator due to proposals put forward for the draft budget during the organization of the budget hearings. Among the 9 members, 4 of them were from the opposition (1 VAKAT, 2 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS, and 1 LDK) and 5 from the position (2 PDK, 2 NISMA and 1 YTAP). Gender representation in this evaluation indicator is 4 (F) to 5 (M). The largest number of proposals during the organization of budget hearings was given by Ymran Fusha (PDK) with a total of 12 proposals, achieving the maximum score in this indicator with 15 points, followed by Marin Përgjoka (LDK) with 10 proposals, Shukri Quni with 8 proposals and Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) with 6 proposals, scoring 10 points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score in this indicator. The other members who have put forward proposals for the budget during the budget hearings and who scored five (5) points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score in this indicator, are: Egzona Hoxha (PDK), Shukrije Berisha (NISMA), Sead Arifi (VAKAT), Ertan Simitci (YTHP), as well as Kujtesa Kabashi – Shatri (Independent Member). It is worth noting that 26 municipal assembly members, during this evaluation period, scored zero (0) points in this indicator due to their lack of commitment in giving proposals during the development of budget hearings for MTBF, as well as the draft budget of the municipality.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely **“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed to members of the executive,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, 27 assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren have performed in this indicator. Out of 27 members who have performed, 19 are among the opposition (8 LVV, 4 LDK, 1 AAK, 1 VAKAT, 1 NDS, 1 KDTP and 3 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS) and 8 among the position (4 PDK, 2 NISMA, 1 YHTP and 1 SDU). In terms of gender, 9 women members (F) and 18 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, 6 municipal assembly members scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than ten (10) questions during the evaluation period. While the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Dafina Alishani (LVV) with a total of 32 questions raised, Ilir Gashi (LVV) with a total of 26 questions raised and Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) with 20 questions raised. In total, 202 different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Prizren during this evaluation period, while such questions raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 3.2, namely **“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”** fourteen (14) members have performed in this indicator, with ten (10) of them among the opposition (6 LVV, 1 VAKAT and 3 INDEPENDENT MEMBERS) and four (4) of them among the position (3 PDK and 1 SDU). Regarding the gender aspect, 9 are men members (M) and 5 others are women members (F).

Within the evaluation of this indicator, 5 municipal assembly members scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score in this indicator due to the fact that they oversee more than ten (10) different projects. Among the members who have overseen more projects are: Ilir Gashi (LVV) with a total of 46 overseen projects, Selman Sokolaj (LVV) with a total of 41 overseen projects and Petrit Hoxhaj (INDEPENDENT MEMBER) with a total of 26 overseen projects during the evaluation period.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane

The Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane has 35 members. In terms of the political configuration, the majority of the Municipal Assembly is made up of the opposition parties led by LDK, PDK, AAK, “Lëvizja Vatra” and “Serbian List,” while the position includes “Lëvizja Vetëvendosje” that governs with Gjilan/Gnjilane, supported in the Assembly by the KDTP and AKR parties. Out of the 35 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane, four are not subject to evaluation based on the performance evaluation methodology, including three (3) heads of parliamentary groups (LVV, LDK and PDK), as well as the chairperson of the municipal assembly. The former chairperson of the assembly of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane, Arianit Sadiku, has been included in the performance evaluation since the hearing of his dismissal³.

It is worth noting that “Lëvizja Vetëvendosje” leads the Gjilan/Gnjilane executive, but it does not enjoy a majority in the municipal assembly, and after the collapse of the coalition between VV and PDK, the new chairperson of the municipal assembly was elected among “Lëvizja Vatra.” The opposition declared in the Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane are LDK, PDK and AAK, “Serbian List,” while AKR and the Turkish party KDTP support “Lëvizja Vetëvendosje” in the assembly.

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 27 members of the Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane scored positive results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, 8 members are from the position (8 LVV) and 19 members from the opposition (13 LDK, 3 PDK, 2 AAK and 1 “Serbian List”). In terms of gender, 9 women members (F) of the Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane have shown a positive performance (5 from LDK, 2 from LVV, 1 from PDK and 1 from AAK), while 18 men members (M) of the municipal assembly have shown a positive performance (8 from LDK, 6 from LVV, 2 from PDK, 1 AAK and 1 from “Serbian List”). Four (4) assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane, during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, did not achieve any results in any of the evaluation indicators and scored zero points. Among the members who scored zero points, 3 are from the position (1 LVV, 1 KDTP and 1 AKR) and one (1) from the opposition (PDK). In terms of gender, 2 women members (F) and 2 men members (M) scored zero points during the evaluation period.

Among the 27 members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, the municipal assembly members who scored higher during the evaluation period are: Gentrit Murseli (LDK) with 79 points, Besnik Shala (LVV) with 65 points, Blerim Haziri (LVV) with 62 points and Gresa Avdiu (LDK) with 57 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The members with poorer performance during this period are: Besim Guda (LDK) with two (2) points, Drenusha Maloku (LDK) with five (5) points, Teuta Suliqi (LDK) with 5 points, Ardita Ukshini (AAK) with five (5) points and Sretan Trajkovic (Serbian List) with five (5) points out of 100 points which is the maximum score for all indicators. The members who did not perform during this period and scored zero (0) points are: Valdrin Bajrami (LVV), Erestina Isufi (PDK), Emrah Ismaili (KDTP) and Sebahate Hajdini (AKR).

The women members (F) of the Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane with the best performance during this period are: Gresa Avdiu (LDK) with 57 points, Ardhmërie Jakupi - Musliu (LVV) with 23 points and Mimoza Kadriu - Qerimi (LVV) with 22 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

There are 18 members of the municipal assembly who for the first time took the office to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 7 women members (F) and 11 men members (M) won the mandate for the first time.

Fifteen (15) members of the municipal assembly have achieved positive results in at least one of the evaluation indicators (5 LVV, 5 LDK, 3 PDK, 1 AAK, 1 "Serbian List"), but the members who have shown better performance in the category of citizens' representation in the first mandate are: Besnik Shala (LVV) with 65 points, Blerim Haziri (LVV) with 62 points, Gresa Avdiu (LDK) with 57 points, and Imran Haziri with 50 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators. In terms of gender in this category, five (5) women members (F) and ten (10) men members (M) of the municipal assembly have scored.

On the other hand, three members of this category did not achieve any result during the evaluation period and scored zero (0) points: Valdrin Bajrami (LVV), Erestina Isufi (PDK) and Sebahate Hajdini (AKR). In terms of gender in this category, two (2) women members (F) and one (1) man member (M) of the municipal assembly scored zero.

As for classification by age, the Municipal Assembly of Gjilan/Gnjilane has 8 members in the 18-35 age group. Among them, six (6) have performed and two (2) have not performed during this evaluation period. Gentry Murseli (LDK) is the member with the best performance in this age group with a total of 79 points, followed by Gresa Avdiu (LDK) with a total of 57 points and Imran Haziri (LDK) with 50 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators. In terms of gender in this age group, there are 3 women members (F) and 3 men members (M) who have performed. The members who have not scored any results in this age group are: Erestina Isufi (PDK) and Emrah Ismaili (KDTP).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane has 11 members in the 36-50 age group. Seven (7) of the assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane in this age group have shown commitment/performed and one (1) of them has scored zero points. The municipal assembly member, Besnik Shala (LVV), is the member with the best performance in this age group with a total of 65 points, followed by Blerim Haziri (LVV) with 62 points and Muhedin Haziri (LDK) with 30 points. In terms of gender in this age group, 4 women members (F) and 6 men members (M) have performed. The municipal assembly member who did not perform in this age group is Valdrin Bajrami (LVV).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane has 12 members in the 51+ age group. Even in this age group, 11 members have shown commitment/performed and one (1) of them scored zero points. The municipal assembly member, Ismail Kurteshi (LVV), is the member with the best performance in this age group with a total of 48 points, followed by Nazim Gagica (AAK) with 30 points, Latif Maliqi (LDK) with 28 points and Sami Ahmeti (LDK) with 27 points, out of 100 points, which is the maximum score in all indicators. In terms of gender in this age group, 2 women members (F) and 9 men members (M) have performed. The municipal assembly member who did not perform in this age group is Sebahate Hajdini (AKR).

Evaluation against indicators

As for the evaluation Indicator 1.1 ***“The number of meetings organized by the municipal assembly members with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups,”*** during the evaluation period, 12 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane have organized a total of 49 meetings with citizens. Gentrif Murseli (LDK) and Gresa Avdiu (LDK), during this period, scored 15 points each, which is the maximum score due to the large number of meetings organized with citizens. Other members who have organized meetings with citizens and have scored 5 points are: Arbër Musliu (LVV), Ardhmërie Jakupi - Musliu (LVV), Besnik Shala (LVV), Blerim Haziri (LVV), Ismajl Kurteshi (LVV), Laurant Shabani (LVV), Mimoza Kadriu – Qerimi (LVV), Imran Haziri (LDK), Sami Ahmeti (LDK) and Ardita Ukshini (AAK). In the framework of 48 such organizations, the participation of citizens belonging to marginalized groups has also been identified; therefore, all members have performed in Indicator 1.2, namely in ***“Number of participants in organized meetings belonging to marginalized groups,”*** except for Sami Ahmeti (LDK), where in the meeting organized with citizens no participants from marginalized groups were identified and this is the reason why he failed to score in Indicator 1.2. As for the position-opposition commitment, seven of these members from the position (7 LVV) and five (5) members from the opposition (4 LDK, 1 AAK) have organized meetings with citizens.

Regarding Indicator 1.3, namely ***“Number of issues/requests raised by municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions with social media”***, during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, eight (8) members have shown commitment/performed. Five (5) members who have scored in this indicator are among the opposition (3 LDK, 1 PDK and 1 AAK) and three (3) among the position (3 LVV). In terms of gender, eight (8) men members (M) have performed in this indicator and no woman member (F) of the assembly has performed in this indicator. Gentrif Murseli (LDK) has raised the largest number of issues/requests in this indicator with a total of 16 issues/requests and is the only member who has scored 15 points, which is the maximum score in this indicator. The municipal assembly member, Blerim Haziri (LVV), raised 8 issues/requests during the evaluation period, Besnik Shala (LVV) raised 6 issues/requests arising from meetings or interactions with social media and scored 10 points out of 15 points, what is the maximum score in this indicator. The members who raised issues/requests arising from meetings with citizens or social interactions are: Imran Haziri (LDK) and Faton Milazimi (PDK) with 3 issues/requests each, Ismajl Kurteshi (LVV) with 2 issues/requests, Muhedin Haziri (LDK) and Nazim Gagica (AAK) with 1 issue/request each and all these members scored five (5) points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score in this indicator. On the other hand, 23 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

In the Indicator 1.4, namely ***“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of Marginalized Groups that were raised in the assembly session,”*** during this period, two members achieved a positive result, Besnik Shala (LVV) with three (3) points and Gentrif Murseli (LDK) with two (2) points out of 5 points, which is the maximum in this indicator. On the other hand, 29 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely ***“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”*** during the evaluation period May 2023 to February 2024, ten (10) municipal assembly members did not raise any issue and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Five (5) of them come among the position (3 LVV, 1 KDTP and 1 AKR) and five (5) among the opposition (2 LDK, 1 PDK, 1 AAK and 1 “Serbian List”).

On the other hand, 21 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane raised issues or requests during the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among the 21 members who have performed, 6 of them are among the position (6 LVV) and 15 among the opposition (11 LDK, 3 PDK and 1 AAK). In terms of gender, 5 women members (F) and 16 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, 6 municipal assembly members scored five (5) points,

which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period.

While the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Muhedin Haziri (LDK) with a total of 20 issues raised, Ismajl Kurteshi (LVV) with a total of 19 issues raised, Gentril Murseli (LDK) with a total of 18 issues raised, Imran Haziri (LDK) with a total of 11 issues raised and Nazim Gagica (AAK) with 9 issues raised. A total of 128 different issues were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane during this evaluation period, while such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 2.2, namely ***“The number of legal initiatives (proposals for municipal regulations, amendments to regulations, decisions, municipal budget) raised by municipal assembly members during the sessions,”*** during the period May 2023 - February 2024, 15 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane have performed in this indicator. Among them, seven (7) are from the position (LVV) and 8 from the opposition (7 LDK and 1 AAK). In terms of gender, four (4) women members (F) and eleven (11) men members (M) of the municipal assembly who performed.

Ismajl Kurteshi (LVV) was the municipal assembly member, who, during the evaluation period, scored the maximum points, namely 10 points due to the proposal of 14 legal initiatives. Gentril Murseli (LDK) during this period proposed 10 legal initiatives and scored seven (7) points, Gresa Avdiu (LDK), Latif Maliqi (LDK), Sami Ahmeti (LDK) are municipal assembly members who have each proposed 4 legal initiatives, Ardhmërie Jakupi Musliu (LVV), Blerim Haziri (LVV), Besnik Shala (LVV), Mimoza Kadriu Qerimi (LVV), Imran Haziri (LDK), Nazim Gagica (AAK), are municipal assembly members who have each proposed 3 legal initiatives, Shpresa Kurtishi Emini (LDK) has proposed 2 legal initiatives, Arianit Sadiku (LVV), Arber Musliu (LVV) and Muhedin Haziri (LDK) have each proposed one (1) legal initiative and as a result of such proposals, these members scored each five (5) points out of 10 points, which is the maximum score for this indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.3, namely ***“The number of proposals put forward during budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality organized by the executive and the legislative,”*** during the monitoring of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality, 26 members have not put forward any proposal for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization of budget hearings. Five (5) members were evaluated positively in this indicator due to the proposals put forward for the draft budget in the budget hearings. Out of 5 members, 3 are among the opposition (2 LDK and 1 AAK) and 2 are among the position (2 LVV). Gender representation in this evaluation indicator was 0 (F) to 5 (M).

The largest number of proposals during the organization of budget hearings was put forward by Blerim Haziri (LVV) with a total of 13 proposals, achieving the maximum score in this indicator with 15 points, followed by Besnik Shala (LVV) and Ekrem Kryeziu (PDK) with 10 proposals each and scored 10 points. Sami Ahmeti (LDK) put forward the smallest number of budget proposals with two (2) proposals and Muhedin Haziri (LDK) with one (1) proposal and scored five (5) points each out of fifteen (15) points, what is the maximum score for this indicator. It is worth noting that 26 municipal assembly members, during this evaluation period, scored zero (0) points in this indicator, due to their lack of commitment in putting forward proposals during the development of budget hearings for MTBF, as well as the draft budget of the municipality.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely ***“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed to members of the executive,”*** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, 23 assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane have performed in this indicator. Out of the 23 members who have performed, 16 of them are among the opposition (12 LDK, 2 PDK, 1 AAK, and 1 “Serbian List”) and 7 among the position (7 LVV). In terms of gender, 8 women members (F) and 15 men members (M) have performed in this indicator.

Within the evaluation of this indicator, nine (9) municipal assembly members scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than ten (10) questions during the

evaluation period. So, the members who raised the largest number of questions during this evaluation period are: Gresa Avdiu (LDK) with a total of 63 questions raised, Imran Haziri (LVV) with a total of 25 questions raised, Gentrît Murseli (LDK) and Afërdita Balaj (LDK) with 23 questions raised each, Sami Ahmeti (LDK) with 20 questions raised, Latif Maliqi (LDK) and Ismajl Kurteshi with 14 questions raised each, Ekrem Kryeziu (PDK) and Nazim Gagica with 12 questions raised each, as well as Muhedin Haziri (LDK) with 11 questions raised. A total of 286 different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Gjilan/Gnjilane during this assessment period, while such questions raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 3.2, namely ***“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”*** during the evaluation period, 10 members have shown commitment. Five (5) of the members are among the LVV and five (5) among the LDK. Regarding the gender aspect, 8 are men members (M) and 2 others are women members (F).

Within the evaluation of this indicator, 3 municipal assembly members scored fifteen (15) points each, which is the maximum score in this indicator due to the fact that they oversee more than ten (10) different projects. Among the members who have overseen more projects are: Gresa Avdiu (LDK) has overseen 14 projects, Gentrît Murseli (LDK) has overseen 12 projects and Besnik Shala (LVV) has overseen 12 projects.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac

The Assembly of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac has 31 members. It is worth noting that “Aleanca për Ardhmërinë e Kosovës (AAK)” leads the executive of Rahovec/Orahovac, but it does not enjoy a majority in the municipal assembly, namely following the transfer of some members from other entities to this entity, it has 15 members (15 AAK). The opposition in the municipal assembly has 16 members, 6 from LDK, 5 from PDK and 5 from LVV. Out of the 31 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac, five (5) of them are not subject to evaluation based on the performance evaluation methodology, including four (4) heads of parliamentary groups (AAK, LVV, LDK and PDK), as well as the chairperson of the municipal assembly. The former chairperson of the assembly of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac, Dëfrim Kafexhiu, has been included in the performance evaluation since the hearing of his dismissal⁴.

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 19 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac scored positive results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, 7 members are from the position (7 AAK) and 12 members from the opposition (5 LDK, 3 PDK and 4 from LVV).

In terms of gender, 8 women members (F) of the Assembly of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac have performed (3 AAK, 2 LVV, 2 LDK and 1 independent member), while 11 men members (M) of the municipal assembly have shown a positive performance (4 AAK, 3 LDK, 2 from LVV, 2 from PDK). Seven (7) assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac, during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, did not score any results in any of the evaluation indicators and scored zero points.

Among the members who did not score any results, 4 are among the position (6 AAK) and one (1) among the opposition (PDK). In terms of gender, 3 women members (F) and men members (M) did not score any results during the evaluation period.

Among the 19 members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, the municipal assembly members who scored higher during the evaluation period are: Ilir Pallqa (LVV) with 59 points, Dafina Gashi (AAK) with 37 points and Sejfullah Sejfullahu with 30 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The members who have poorer performance during this period are: Fahrije Lushi Morina (LDK) with 7 points, Besim Berisha (AAK) with five (5) points, Rumir Zhuniqi (AAK) with five (5) points, Shqi

Kryeziu (AAK) with five (5) points, Melinda Iska (PDK) with five (5) points out of 100 points, which is the maximum rating for all indicators.

The members who did not perform during this period and scored zero (0) points are: Alban Bajraktari (AAK), Bjondina Kleqka (AAK), Dorentina Sopjani (AAK), Feriz Thaqi (AAK), Shukrije Himaj (AAK) and Armir Vuçitërna (PDK).

The women members (F) of the Municipal Assembly of Rahovec/Orahovac with the best performance during this period are: Dafina Gashi (AAK) with 37 points, Merisa Sharku – Vuçitërna (LVV) with 28 points and Vlora Vuçitërna – Çmega (LVV) with 20 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

Nineteen (19) municipal assembly members for the first time took the office to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 8 women members (F) and 11 men members (M) won the mandate for the first time.

Fourteen (14) municipal assembly members have shown positive results in at least one of the evaluation indicators (5 AAK, 4 LVV, 3 LDK, 2 PDK), but the members who have shown better performance in the category of citizen representation in the first mandate are: Ilir Pallqa (LVV) with 59 points, Dafina Gashi (AAK) with 37 points and Sejfulla Sejfullahu (PDK) with 30 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators. On the other hand, there are five (5) members in this category who did not score any results during the evaluation period and scored zero (0) points: Alban Bajraktari (AAK), Dorentina Sopjani (AAK), Feriz Thaqi (AAK), Shukrije Himaj (AAK) and Armir Vuçitërna (PDK).

As for classification by age, the Municipal Assembly of Rahovec/Orahovac has 12 members in the 18-35 age group. Among them, ten (10) have performed and two (2) have not performed during this evaluation period. Ilir Pallqa (LVV) is the member with the best performance in this age group with a total of 59 points, followed by Dafina Gashi (AAK) with a total of 37 points, Merisa Sharku – Vucitërna (LVV) with a total of 28 points and Drilon Mustafa (AAK) with 27 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators. In terms of gender in this age group, 5 women members (F) and 5 men members (M) have performed, while there are two (2) women members (F) who have not performed in this age group. The members who have not scored any results in this age group are: Bjondina Kleqka (AAK) and Dorontina Sopjani (AAK).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac has 10 members in the 36-50 age group. Five (5) assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac in this age group have shown commitment/performed and five (5) of them did not perform and scored zero points. The municipal assembly member, Sejfullah Sejfullahu (PDK), has the best performance in this age group with a total of 30 points, followed by Faton Ramadani (LDK) with eight (8) points and Farije Lushi - Morina with seven (7) points. In terms of gender in this age group, 3 women members (F) and 2 men members (M) have performed. The municipal assembly members who did not perform in this age group are: Alban Bajraktari (AAK), Shukrije Himaj (AAK), Feriza Thaqi (AKK), Sinan Kryeziu (AAK) and Armir Vuçitërna (PDK).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac has 4 members in the 51+ age group. In this age group, 4 members showed commitment/performed, whereas the municipal assembly members, Sejfulla Sejfullahu (PDK) and Rasim Fazliu (PDK), had the best performance in this age group with a total of 30 points, namely 23 points out of 100 points which is the maximum score for all indicators.

Evaluation against indicators

As for the evaluation Indicators 1.1 *“The number of meetings organized by members of the municipal assembly with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups,”* as well as 1.2 *“Number of participants in organized meetings belonging to marginalized groups,”* during the evaluation period, Dafina Gashi (from the position namely from AAK), is the member who has organized two (2) meetings with citizens belonging to marginalized groups and has scored in these two indicators, as well

as Ilir Pallqa (LVV) during this evaluation period has organized one (1) meeting with citizens, but no members from marginalized groups attended and has therefore scored only in Indicator 1.1.

Regarding Indicator 1.3, namely **“The number of issues/requests raised by municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions in social media,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, eight (8) members have shown commitment/performed. Five (5) members who have achieved results in this indicator are among the opposition (4 LVV, 1 LDK) and three (3) among the position (3 AAK). In terms of gender, five (5) men members (M) and three (3) women members (F) of the assembly have performed in this indicator.

The largest number of issues/requests in this indicator was raised by Ilir Pallqa (LVV) with a total of 9 issues/requests and he is the only member who has scored ten (10) points in this indicator. The other members who scored (5) points and who raised issues/requests arising from meetings with citizens or social interactions are: Merisa Sharku (LVV) with three (3) issues/requests, Vlora Vuqiterna (LVV) with two (2) issues/requests and Afrim Berisha (AAK), Drilon Mustafa (AAK), Florida Bajraktari (AAK), Dëfrim Kafexhiu (LVV), Lirigzon Kastrati (LDK) with 1 issue/request each. On the other hand, 18 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Indicator 1.4, namely **“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of Marginalized Groups which were raised in the session of the assembly,”** during this period, one member scored a positive result, Ilir Pallqa (LVV) with two (2) points out of 5 points, which is the maximum in this indicator. On the other hand, 25 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely **“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by members of the municipal assembly during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, thirteen (13) members of the municipal assembly did not raise any issue and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Ten (10) of them are from the position (10 AAK) and three (3) from the position (2 PDK, 1 LVV).

On the other hand, 13 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac have raised issues or requests at the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among the 13 members who have performed in this indicator, 3 of them are from the position (3 AAK) and 10 from the opposition (5 LDK, 3 LVV and 2 PDK). In terms of gender, 4 women members (F) and 9 men members (M) have performed in this indicator.

Within the evaluation of this indicator, 3 municipal assembly members scored five (5) points which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period. So, the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Lirigzon Kastrati (LDK) with a total of 13 issues raised, Sejfullah Sejfullahu (PDK) with a total of 11 issues raised and Valmir Gashi (AAK) with a total of 7 issues raised. A total of 68 different issues were raised by assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac during this assessment period, while such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.).

Regarding Indicator 2.2, namely **“Number of legislative initiatives (municipal regulations, proposals for amending regulations, budget) proposed by members of the municipal assembly during the assembly session,”** during the period May 2023 - February 2024, five (5) assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac have performed in this indicator. Among them, one (1) is from the position (AAK) and four (4) from the opposition (2 LVV and 2 AAK). In terms of gender, two (2) women members and three (3) men members of the municipal assembly have performed.

During this period, Ilir Pallqa (LVV) proposed 3 legal initiatives and Dafina Gashi (AAK), Merisa Sharku (LVV), Sejfullah Sejfullahu (PDK) and Rasim Fazliu (PDK) have each put forward one (1) proposal for legal initiatives. As a result of such proposals, these members scored five (5) points each out of 10 points, which is the maximum score for this indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.3, namely ***“The number of proposals during the budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality organized by the executive and the legislative”***, during the monitoring of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality, 22 members did not put forward any proposal for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization of the budget hearings. Four (4) members have been positively evaluated in this indicator as they have put forward proposals for the draft budget during the organization of the budget hearings. Among the 4 members, 2 of them are from the opposition (1 LVV and 1 PDK) and 2 from the position (2 AAK). Gender representation in this evaluation indicator was 1 (F) to 3 (M).

The largest number of proposals during the organization of budget hearings was put forward by Sejfullah Sejfullahu (PDK) with a total of 5 proposals, Dafina Gashi (AAK) and Drilon Mustafa (AAK) with 3 proposals each and Ilir Pallqa (LVV) with 1 proposal. Four of these members scored five (5) points out of ten (10) points, which is the maximum score for this indicator. It is worth noting that 22 municipal assembly members during this evaluation period scored (0) points in this indicator, due to the lack of their commitment in putting forward proposals during the budget hearings for MTBF, as well as the draft budget of the municipality.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely ***“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed by municipal assembly members to the executive members,”*** during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, 18 assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac have performed in this indicator. Out of 18 members who have performed, 12 are from the opposition (5 LDK, 3 PDK, and 4 LVV) and 6 from the position (6 AAK). In terms of gender, 8 women members (F) and 10 men members (M) have performed in this indicator.

Within the evaluation of this indicator, 6 municipal assembly members scored fifteen (15) points, which is the highest score due to the fact that they raised more than ten (10) questions during the evaluation period. While the members who have raised the largest number of questions during this evaluation period are: Dëfrim Kafexhiu (LVV), Ilir Pallqa (LVV), Lirigzon Kastrati (LDK), Edona Kryeziu (LDK) with 21 questions each and Vlora Vuçitërna (LVV) and Rasim Fazliu (PDK) with 12 questions each. In total, 160 different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Rahovec/Orahovac during this evaluation period, while such questions raised during this period were mainly of an infra-structural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting, etc.)

On the other hand, 8 other members have not performed in this indicator. Out of them, 7 are from the position AAK and 1 from the opposition (1 PDK). In terms of gender, 3 women members (F) and 5 men members (M) are among those who have not shown performance in this indicator.

Regarding indicator 3.2 respectively ***“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”*** during the evaluation period, 6 members have shown commitment. Two (2) of the members are from the position (2 AAK) and four (4) from the opposition (3 LVV, 1 PDK). Regarding the gender aspect, 4 are men members (M) and 2 others are women members (F).

During the evaluation of this indicator, Ilir Pallqa (LVV) is the only municipal assembly member who scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score in this indicator due to the fact that he overseed more than six (6) various projects. Among the members who have overseed more projects are: Ilir Pallqa (LVV) has overseed 9 projects, Dafina Gashi (AAK) has overseed 5 projects, Drilon Mustafa (AAK) has overseed 2 projects and Merisa Sharku (LVV), Dëfrim Kafexhiu (LVV) and Fejzullah Fejzullahu (PDK) overseed 1 project each.

On the other hand, 20 other members have not performed in this indicator. Of them, 10 are from the position (AAK) and 10 from the opposition (2 LVV, 5 LDK and 3 PDK). In terms of gender, 9 women members (F) and 11 men members (M) are among those who have not performed in this indicator.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo

Assembly of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo has 31 members. The position in the municipal assembly has 16 members, 10 from NISMA and 6 from LDK, while the opposition has 15 members (8 from PDK, 5 from LVV and 2 from AAK). Out of 31 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo, six (6) of them are not subject to the evaluation based on the performance evaluation methodology, including five (5) heads of parliamentary groups (NISMA, LDK, PDK, LVV and AAK), as well as the chairperson of the municipal assembly.

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 16 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo have scored positive results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators are 7 members from the position (5 NISMA and 2 LDK) and 9 members from the opposition (5 PDK and 4 from LVV).

In terms of gender, 6 women members (F) of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo have performed (2 NISMA, 2 PDK and 2 LVV), whereas 10 men members (M) of the municipal assembly have scored a positive performance (3 NISMA, 3 PDK, 2 LDK and 2 LVV).

Nine (9) assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo, during the evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, did not achieve any results in any of the evaluation indicators and thus scored zero points. Among the members who did not score any results, 6 are from the position (4 NISMA and 2 LDK) and three (3) from the opposition (2 PDK and 1 AAK). In terms of gender, 5 women members (F) and 4 men members (M) did not score any results during the evaluation period.

Among the 16 members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, municipal assembly members who scored higher during the evaluation period are: Amrush Helshani (NISMA) with 52 points, Burim Paqarizi (PDK) and Alban Kastrati (PDK) with 20 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The members with poorer performance during this period are: Bledar Kryeziu (PDK), Rukije Bytyqi (NISMA), Arlind Morina (LVV) and Arbnore Hoti (LVV) with 2 points each.

The members who did not perform during this period and scored zero (0) points are: Bashkim Berisha (NISMA), Hasim Rudi (NISMA), Urim Thaqi (NISMA), Fjoralba Hoxha (NISMA), Sadik Vrenezi (PDK), Arlinda Rudi (PDK), Zamire Morina (LDK), Adile Hoxha (LDK) and Donjeta Shijaku (AAK).

The women members (F) of the Municipal Assembly of Malishevë/Mališevo with the best performance during this period are: Agnesa Kastrati (LVV) with 15 points, Gentiana Morina (NISMA), Merlinde Gashi (PDK) and Valjete Hoti (PDK) with 7 points each out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

From the point of view of the representation of political entities, nine (9) assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo represented by different political entities have been evaluated negatively and among them are four (4) members from NISMA, 2 from PDK, 2 from LDK and 1 from AAK.

18 municipal assembly members took the office for the first time to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 9 women members (F) and 9 men members (M) took the office for the first time. Among the members who took the office for the first time, eight (8) of them did not show any results during the evaluation period and were scored with zero (0) points. Six of them (6) come from the position (4 NISMA and 2 LDK) and two from the opposition (2 PDK). In terms of gender, four (4) women members (F) and four (4) men members (M) have not performed in any of the evaluation indicators during this period.

On the other hand, ten (10) members in this category have shown results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who have shown results during the evaluation period, five (5) come from the position (4 NISMA and 1 LDK) and five (5) from the opposition (3 PDK and 2 LVV). In terms of gender, in this category there are five (5) women members (F) and five (5) men members (M) who have performed in the evaluation indicators during this period. Among these members who have performed better in this category are: Amrush Helshani (NISMA), Valon Mazreku (NISMA), Burim Paqarizi (PDK) and Agnesa Kastrati (LVV).

As for classification by age, the Malishevë/Mališevo Municipal Assembly has 14 members of age 18-35. Among them, six (6) members did not show any performance, among them four (4) from the position (2 NISMA and 2 LDK) as well as two (2) from the opposition (1 PDK and 1 AAK). In terms of gender, five (5) women members (F) and one (1) man member (M) of the municipal assembly did not perform in this category.

On the other hand, in this age group there are eight (8) assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo who have performed. Among them, three (3) come from the position (3 NISMA) and five (5) from the opposition (3 PDK and 2 LVV). In terms of gender, three (3) women members (F) and five (5) men members of the Municipal Assembly performed in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group are: Amrush Helshani (NISMA), Burim Paqarizi (PDK) and Agnesa Kastrati (LVV).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo has 11 members in the 36-50 age group. Among them, three (3) members did not perform, among them two (2) from the position (2 NISMA) and one (1) from the opposition (1 PDK). In terms of gender, three (3 F) women members of the Municipal Assembly did not perform in this category.

On the other hand, this age group consists of eight (8) assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo who have performed. Among them, four (4) come from the position (2 NISMA and 2 LDK) and four (4) from the opposition (2 LVV and 2 PDK). In terms of gender, three (3) women members (F) and five (5) men members of the municipal assembly performed in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group: Alban Kastrati (PDK), Valon Krasniqi (LVV) and Valon Mazreku (NISMA).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo has no member in the 51+ age group for evaluation.

Evaluation against indicators

Regarding evaluation Indicator 1.1 ***“Number of meetings organized by members of the municipal assembly with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups”*** and Indicator 1.2 ***“Number of participants in organized meetings belonging to marginalized groups,”*** during the evaluation period Amrush Helshani (from the position i.e. NISMA), is the member who has organized eight (8) meetings with citizens, namely with groups belonging to marginalized groups and is the member who has been

evaluated in these two indicators (Indicators 1.1 and 1.2) . On the other hand, 24 members of the Malishevë/Mališevo Municipal Assembly during the evaluation period, did not organize any meeting with citizens or marginalized groups, being evaluated with zero (0) points in two of the indicators, namely indicator 1.1 and 1.2.

Regarding indicator 1.3, namely **“Number of issues/requests raised by the municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions with social media”**, during this evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, there are four (4) members who have marked commitment/ performance. The four (4) members who showed results in this indicator are from the opposition (2 PDK and 1 LVV) and one (1) from the position (1 NISMA). In terms of gender, four (4) men members (M) of the Assembly have performed in this indicator.

The largest number of issues/requests in this indicator was raised by Amrush Helshani (NISMA) with a total of 7 issues/requests and he is the only member who scored ten (10) points in this indicator. The other members who scored five (5) points and who have raised issues/requests arising from meetings with citizens or social interactions are: Valon Krasniqi (LVV) with 5 issues/requests raised, as well as Burim Paqarizi (PDK) and Bledar Kryeziu (PDK) with one (1) issue/request each. On the other hand, there are 21 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo who scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 1.4, namely **“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of marginalized groups raised in the assembly session,”** during this period, one member scored a positive result, Amrush Helshani (NISMA) from the position. On the other hand, there are 24 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo who scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely **“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 to February 2024, eleven (11) municipal assembly members did not raise any issue and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Seven (7) of them are from the position (4 NISMA, 3 LDK) and four (4) from the opposition (3 PDK, 1 AAK). In terms of gender, 5 women members (F) and 6 men members (M) have not performed in this indicator.

On the other hand, 14 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo raised issues or requests during the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among the 14 members who have performed in this indicator, 6 of them are from the position (5 NISMA and 1 LDK) and 8 from the opposition (4 LVV and 4 PDK). In terms of gender, 6 women members (F) and 8 men members (M) have scored in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, 5 municipal assembly members scored five (5) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period.

While the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Vlon Mazreku (NISMA) with a total of 18 issues raised, Alban Kastrati (PDK) with a total of 14 issues raised, Valon Krasniqi (LVV) with a total of 13 issues raised, Burim Paqarizi (PDK) with 11 issues raised and Agnesa Kastrati (LVV) with 9 issues raised. In total, 85 different issues were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo during this evaluation period, while such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 2.2, namely **“The number of legal initiatives (proposals for municipal regulations, amendments to regulations, decisions, municipal budget) raised by municipal assembly members during the sessions,”** during the period May 2023 and February 2024, four (4) assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo have performed in this indicator. Among them, three (3) come from the position (2 NISMA and 1 LDK) and one (1) from the opposition (1 LVV). In terms of gender, one (1) woman member and three (3) men members of the Municipal Assembly have performed.

During this period, Driton Kastrati (LDK) and Valon Krasniqi (LVV) proposed 2 legal initiatives each, and Valon Mazreku (NISMA) and Gentiana Hoti (NISMA) each have put forward one (1) proposal for legal

initiatives. As a result of such proposals, these members scored five (5) points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score for this indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.3, namely **“The number of proposals during the budget hearings for MTBF and the draft municipal budget organized by the executive and legislative,”** during the monitoring of the budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality, none of the members of the Assembly of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo did not put forward any proposal for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization of the budget hearings.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely **“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed to the executive members,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 and February 2024, 9 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo have performed in this indicator. Out of 9 members who have performed, 4 of them are from the position (2 NISMA and 2 LDK) and 5 from the opposition (4 PDK and 1 LVV). In terms of gender, 3 women members (F) and 6 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, Alban Kastrati is the municipal assembly member who scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that raised more than ten (10) questions during the evaluation period. So, the members who have raised the largest number of questions during this evaluation period are: Alban Kastrati (LVV) with 15 questions raised, Amrush Helshani (NISMA), Burim Paqarizi (PDK) and Agnesa Kastrati (LVV) with 10 questions raised each. In total, 52 different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo during this evaluation period, where questions raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting etc.)

Regarding Indicator 3.2, namely **“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”** during the evaluation period there are 2 members who have shown commitment, and both (2) members are from the position (2 NISMA).

Within the evaluation of this indicator, Amrush Helshani (NISMA) is the municipal assembly member who scored ten (10) points, which is the maximum score in this indicator due to the fact that he has overseen six (6) different projects, and Astrit Sertolli (NISMA) with five (5) points due to the fact that he has overseen 3 different projects. On the other hand, 23 assembly members of the Municipality of Malishevë/Mališevo who were subject to the performance evaluation, during this period did not have any initiative to oversee the implementation of various projects by the municipal executive bodies.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok

The Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok has 27 members. Out of the 27 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok, five (5) are not subject to the evaluation based on the performance evaluation methodology, including four (4) heads of parliamentary groups (LDK, PDK, AAK and LVV) as well as the chairperson of the Municipal Assembly.

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 21 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok scored positive results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, ten (10) members are from the position (8 LDK and 2 PDK) and 11 members from the opposition (6 AAK, 4 LVV and 1 GIBPDK). In terms of gender, 9 women members (F) of the Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok have performed (3 LDK, 3 AAK, 2 LVV and 1 PDK), whereas 12 men members (M) of the Municipal Assembly have shown a positive performance (5 LDK, 3 AAK, 2 LVV, 1 PDK and 1 GIBI). During this evaluation period, one (1) municipal assembly member did not achieve any result in the evaluation indicators and scored zero (0) points.

Among the 21 members who scored positive results in the evaluation indicators, municipal assembly members who scored higher during the evaluation period are: Niman Beqiraj (LVV) with 40 points, Nexhdet Ramaj (AAK) with 32 points and Arta Balaj (LDK) with 26 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The members with the poorer performance during this period are: Visar Haxhijaj (PDK) with two (2) points, and Faik Alushaj (LDK), Faruk Kabashi (LDK), Ruzhdi Metaj (LDK), Arianit Amiraj (AAK), Ardita Idrizaj (AAK), Nexhmedin Balaj (AAK), and Melis Smakiç (GIBI) each scored five (5) points. On the other hand, the member who did not perform during this period and scored zero (0) points is Njomza Demaj (LDK).

The women members (F) of the Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok with the best performance during this period are: Arta Balaj (LDK) with 26 points, Ajshe Metaj (AAK) with 23 points and Floriana Maxharaj with 22 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

13 municipal assembly members took the office for the first time to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 5 women members (F) and 8 men members (M) took the office for the first time. Among the members who took the office for the first time, thirteen (13) have shown results during the evaluation period, where five (5) come from the position (4 LDK and 1 PDK) and eight (8) from the opposition (4 AAK, 3 LVV and 1 GIBI). Among these members who performed better in this category are: Niman Beqiraj (LVV) with 40 points, Nexhdet Ramaj (AAK) with 32 points and Arta Balaj (LDK) with 26 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

As for the classification by age, the Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok has 9 members in the 18-35 age group. Among them, one (1) member did not perform (1 LDK). On the other hand, this age group consists of eight (8) assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok who have performed. Among them, four (4) are from the position (3 LDK and 1 PDK) and four (4) from the opposition (2 LVV, 1 AAK and 1 GIBI). In terms of gender, five (5) women members (F) and three (3) men members (M) of the municipal assembly did not perform in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group are: Niman Beqiraj (LVV), Arta Balaj (LDK) and Floriana Maxharraj (LVV).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok has 9 members in the 36 – 50 age group. In this age group there are nine (9) assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok who have performed. Among them, four (4) are from the position (3 LDK and 1 PDK) and five (5) from the opposition (4 AAK and 1 LVV). In terms of gender, one (1) woman member (F) and eight (8) men members (M) of the Municipal Assembly performed in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group are: Negjdet Ramaj (AAK) and Arian Shatri (LVV).

The Assembly of the Municipality of Istog/Istok has 4 members in the 51+ age group. This age group consists of four (4) assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok who have performed. Among them, two (2) come from the position (2 LDK) and two (2) from the opposition (1 AAK and 1 LVV). In terms of gender, three (3) women members (F) and one (1) man member of the Municipal Assembly have performed in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group are: Ajshe Metaj (AAK) and Valbone Demaj (LDK).

Evaluation against indicators

Regarding evaluation Indicator 1.1, ***“The number of meetings organized by the municipal assembly members with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups”*** and Indicator 1.2 ***“The number of participants belonging to marginalized groups in the meetings organized,”*** during the evaluation period Arta Balaj (from the position, namely from LDK), is the member who has organized one (1) meeting with citizens, where citizens belonging to marginalized groups have participated and is the only member who has scored in these two indicators (indicators 1.1 and 1.2). On the other hand, 21 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok, during the evaluation period, did not organize any meeting with citizens or marginalized groups, thus scoring zero (0) points in two of the indicators, namely indicators 1.1 and 1.2.

Regarding Indicator 1.3, namely ***“The number of issues/requests raised by the municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions in social media,”*** during this evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, two (2) members have shown commitment/ performed. One (1) member who has shown a result in this indicator comes from the opposition (1 LVV) and one (1) from the position (1 PDK). In terms of gender, one (1) woman member (F) and one (1) man member (M) of the assembly have performed in this indicator.

The other members who scored five (5) points and who raised issues/requests arising from meetings with citizens or social interactions are: Arian Shatri (LVV) with 1 issue/request raised, as well as Era Visoqi (PDK) with one (1) issue/request raised. On the other hand, 20 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Indicator 1.4 namely ***“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of marginalized groups that were raised in the assembly session,”*** during this period, two members have achieved a positive result, Era Visoqi (LVV) and Arian Shatri (LVV) with five (5) points each. On the other hand, 20 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok scored zero points in this evaluation indicator.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely ***“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”*** during the evaluation period May 2023 to February 2024, ten (10) municipal assembly members

did not raise any issue and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Six (6) are from the position (5 LDK and 1 PDK) and four (4) from the opposition (2 AAK, 1 LVV and 1 GIBI). In terms of gender, 7 men members (M) and three (3) women members (F) have not performed in this indicator.

On the other hand, 12 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok raised issues or requests during the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among 12 members who have performed in this indicator, 6 are from the position (5 LDK and 1 PDK) and 6 from the opposition (3 LVV and 3 AAK). In terms of gender, 7 women members (F) and 5 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, one (1) municipal assembly member scored five (5) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that he raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period.

Therefore, the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Niman Beqiraj (LVV) with a total of 17 issues raised, Valbone Demaj (LDK) and Ajshe Metaj (AAK) with 5 issues each. In total, 40 different issues were raised by assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok during this evaluation period, whereas such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.)

Regarding the Indicator 2.2, namely ***“The number of legal initiatives (proposals for municipal regulations, amendments to regulations, decisions, municipal budget) raised by municipal assembly members during the sessions,”*** during the period May 2023 February 2024, four (4) assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok have performed in this indicator.

Among them, two (2) are from the position (2 LDK) and two (2) from the opposition (2 AAK). In terms of gender, there are three (3) women members (F) and one (1) member of the Municipal Assembly who have shown performance. During this period, Ajshe Metaj (AAK) proposed 2 legal initiatives and Arta Balaj (LDK), Hajrush Shoshi (LDK) and Fjolla Ukaj (AAK) gave one (1) proposal for legal initiatives each. As a result of such proposals, these members scored five (5) points out of 10 points, which is the maximum rating for this indicator.

Regarding the Indicator 2.3, namely ***“The number of proposals during the budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality organized by the executive and legislative,”*** during the monitoring of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality, 21 members have not put forward any proposal for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization of budget hearings. The member who was evaluated positively comes from the position (LDK) Valbone Demaj, who put forward 5 proposals for the draft budget during the organization of the budget hearings and scored five (5) points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score for this indicator.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely ***“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed to executive members,”*** during the evaluation period of May 2023 and February 2024, 16 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok have performed in this indicator. Out of 16 members who have performed, 7 of them are from the position (7 LDK) and 9 from the opposition (6 AAK and 3 LVV). In terms of gender, 8 women members (F) and 8 men members (M) have performed in this indicator.

Within the evaluation of this indicator, Ajshe Metaj (AAK), Negjdet Ramaj (AAK), Floriana Maxharraj (LVV) and Niman Beqiraj (LVV) are the municipal assembly members who have scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than ten (10) questions during the evaluation period. So the members who have raised the largest number of questions during this evaluation period are: Ajshe Metaj (AAK) and Niman Beqiraj (LVV) with 18 questions each, Negjdet Ramaj (AAK) with 13 questions and Floriana Maxharraj (LVV) with 9 questions raised. In total, 85 different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok during this evaluation period, while such questions raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 3.2, namely ***“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”*** during the evaluation period, 6 members have shown commitment and three (3) of the members are among the position (3 LDK) and three (3) among the opposition (1 AAK, 1 LVV and 1 GIBI).

Within the evaluation of this indicator, Niman Beqiraj (LVV) is the municipal assembly member who scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score in this indicator since he overseed ten (10) different projects, and Negjdet Ramaj (AAK) scored ten (10) points due to the fact that he overseed 4 different projects. Arta Balaj (LDK), Ruzhdi Metaj (LDK), Valbone Demaj (LDK) and Melis Smakic (GIBI) each scored five (5) points in this indicator. On the other hand, 16 assembly members of the Municipality of Istog/Istok who were subject of the performance evaluation, during this period did not have any initiative to oversee the implementation of various projects by the municipal executive.

Performance of assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot

The Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot has 15 members. Out of 15 assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot, the chairperson of the Municipality Assembly is not subject to the evaluation but for 14 other members the performance was evaluated during the period of May 2023 - February 2024. The opposition in the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot has 9 members (3 SN.Sloga, 2 N.Jedinstvo, 2 IQK Mogilla, 1 LVV and 1 PDK), whereas the position has 6 members (5 "Serbian List" and 1 LDK).

During the period May 2023 - February 2024, 10 assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot have achieved positive results in the evaluation indicators. Among the members who have achieved positive results in the evaluation indicators are 5 members from the position (4 "Serbian List" and 1 LDK) and 5 members from the opposition (1 SN Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla, 1 LVV and 1 PDK). In terms of gender, 3 women members (F) of the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot have performed (2 "Serbian List" and 1 LDK), whereas 7 men members (M) of the Municipal Assembly have shown positive performance (2 "Serbian List", 1 SN Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla, 1 LVV and 1 PDK).

During this evaluation period, four (4) members of the Municipal Assembly did not achieve any results in the evaluation indicators and were evaluated with zero (0) points. Among the members who did not score positive results in the evaluation indicators from opposition are 4 members (2 SN Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, and 1 IQK Mogilla). In terms of gender, 3 women members (F) of the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot did not perform (1 S.N Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla) while 1 man member (M) of the Municipal Assembly did not show a positive performance (1 S.N Sloga).

Among the 10 members who have achieved positive results in the evaluation indicators, the municipal assembly members who have scored higher during the evaluation period are: Admirim Etemi (LVV) with 28 points, as well as Shqiprim Rexhepi (IQK Mogilla) and Naser Shabani each with 20 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

The members with poorer performance during this period are: Mirjana Spasic (Serbian List) and Dejan Nojkic (Serbian List) with five (5) points each and Igor Petkovic (Serbian List) with 2 points.

On the other hand, the members who did not perform during this period and scored zero (0) points are: Milorad Mirkovic (S.N Sloga), Kristina Vesic (S.N Sloga), Sladjana Cvetkovic (N.Jedinstvo) and Nermina Fejza (IQK Mogilla).

The (F) women members of the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot with the best performance during this period are: Dragana Jeremic (Serbian List) with 7 points and Mirjana Spasic (Serbian List) with 5 points out of 100 points which is the maximum score for all indicators.

10 municipal assembly members took the office for the first time to represent the citizens in this institution. In terms of gender in this category, 6 women members (F) and 4 men members (M) took the office for the first time.

Among the members who took the office for the first time, seven (7) of them have shown results during the evaluation period, where four (4) come from the position (3 Serbian List and 1 LDK) and three (3) from the opposition (1 S.N Sloga, 1 N.Jedinstvo and 1 LVV). Among these members who have performed better in this category are: Admirim Etemi (LVV) with 28 points and Sasa Markovic (N.Jedinstvo) with 15 points out of 100 points, which is the maximum score for all indicators.

As for the classification by age, the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot has 5 members in the 18-35 age group. Among them, one (1) member did not perform (1 S.N Sloga). On the other hand, in this age group are four (4) assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot who have performed. Among them, one (1) comes from the position (1 Serbian List) and three (3) from the opposition (S.N Sloga, IQK Mogilla and 1 LVV). In terms of gender, one (1) woman member (F) and three (3) men members (M) of the Municipal Assembly performed in this category. Among these members who have performed better in this age group are: Admirim Etemi (LVV) with 28 points and Shqiprim Rexhepi (IQK Mogilla) with 20 points.

The Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot has 7 members in the 36- 50 age group. This age group consists of five (5) assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot have performed. Among them, four (4) come from the position (3 Serbian List and 1 LDK) and one (1) from the opposition (1 N.Jedinstvo). In terms of gender, one (1) woman member (F) and one (1) man member (M) of the Municipal Assembly did not perform in this category. Among the members who have performed better in this age group are: Sasa Markovic (N.Jedinstvo) with 15 points and Dragana Jeremic (Serbian List) with 7 points.

The Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot has 2 members in the 51+ age group. Among them, two (2) come from the opposition (1 PDK and 1 N.Jedinstvo) and in terms of gender, there are (2) men members (M) of the Municipal Assembly in this category. Among these members who performed better in this age group is Naser Shabani (PDK), while Sladjana Cvetkovic (N.Jedinstvo) did not perform in this age group and scored zero (0) points.

Evaluation against indicators

Regarding evaluation Indicator 1.1 ***“The number of meetings organized by municipal assembly members with local councils, citizens and marginalized groups”*** and Indicator 1.2 ***“The number of participants belonging to marginalized groups in meetings organized,”*** during the evaluation period none of the assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Klllokot has organized meetings with citizens and underrepresented groups; therefore, indicators 1.1 and 1.2 remain with negative performance.

Regarding Indicator 1.3, namely ***“The number of issues/requests raised by the municipal assembly members during the session resulting from meetings with citizens and interactions in social media,”*** during this evaluation period May 2023 - February 2024, two (2) members who have shown commitment/ performed. Two (2) members who have shown results in this indicator are from the opposition (1 LVV and 1 PDK). In terms of gender, two (2) men members (M) of the assembly have performed in this indicator.

The members who scored five (5) points and who raised issues/requests arising from meetings with citizens or social interactions are: Naser Shabani (PDK) with 2 issues/requests raised and Admirim Etemi (LVV) with one (1) issue/request raised. On the other hand, 12 assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot scored zero points in this evaluation of indicators.

Indicator 1.4, namely **“The number of issues/requests related to the interest of marginalized groups which were raised in the assembly session”** remains among the indicators in which no positive result was achieved by the municipal assembly members during this evaluation period.

Regarding Indicator 2.1, namely **“The number of other issues/requests of public interest proposed by municipal assembly members during the session which are not related to meetings with citizens,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 to February 2024, six (6) municipal assembly members did not raise any issue and as a result scored zero points in this indicator. Two (2) of them come from the position (2 Serbian List) and four (4) from the opposition (2 S.N Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla). In terms of gender, 4 women members (F) and 2 men members (M) have not performed in this indicator.

On the other hand, eight (8) members of the Assembly of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot raised issues or requests during the sessions held during the evaluation period. Among the 8 members who have performed in this indicator, 3 of them are from the position (2 Serbian List and 1 LDK) and 5 from the opposition (1 S.N Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla, 1 LVV and 1 PDK). In terms of gender, 2 women members (F) and 6 men members (M) have performed in this indicator. Within the evaluation of this indicator, three (3) municipal assembly members have scored five (5) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that they raised more than seven (7) issues or requests during the evaluation period.

Whereas the members who raised the largest number of issues during this evaluation period are: Naser Shabani (PDK), Sasa Mirkovic (N.Jedinstvo) and Shqiprim Rexhepi (IQK Mogilla) with 8 issues each. In total, 38 different issues were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot during this evaluation period, while such issues raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, lighting, etc.).

Regarding Indicator 2.2, namely **“The number of legal initiatives (proposals for municipal regulations, amendments to regulations, decisions, municipal budget) raised by municipal assembly members during the sessions,”** during the period May 2023 - February 2024, the municipal assembly member, Shqiprim Rexhepi, was the only one who proposed 1 legal initiative during this period.

Regarding Indicator 2.3, namely **“The number of proposals during the development of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft budget of the municipality organized by the executive and the legislative,”** during the monitoring of budget hearings for MTBF and the draft municipal budget, 12 members have not put forward any proposal for the draft budget of the municipality during the organization of the budget hearings, whereas two (2) members have been evaluated positively in this indicator due to the proposals put forward for the draft budget during the organization of the budget hearings. The members who have been positively evaluated is Mirjana Spasic (Serbian List) and Admirim Etemi (LVV), where each put forward 1 proposal for a draft budget during the organization of budget hearings and scored five (5) points out of 15 points, which is the maximum score for this indicator.

Regarding the Indicator 3.1, namely **“The number of questions and requests for reporting addressed to the executive members,”** during the evaluation period May 2023 and February 2024, 7 assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot have performed in this indicator and 7 others have not performed. Out of 7 of them who have performed, 5 are from the opposition (1 S.N Sloga, 1 Jedinstvo, 1 IQK Mogilla, 1 LVV and 1 PDK) and two (2) of them from the position (2 Serbian List). In terms of gender, 1 woman member (F) and 6 men members (M) have performed in this indicator.

Within the evaluation of this indicator, one (1) member scored fifteen (15) points, which is the maximum score due to the fact that he raised more than ten (10) questions during the evaluation period. So, the members who raised the largest number of questions during this evaluation period are: Admirim Etemi (LVV) with 23 questions raised, Sasa Mirkovic (N.Jedinstvo) with 10 questions raised, Naser Shabani (PDK) with 9 questions raised and Shqiprim Rexhepi (IQK Mogilla) with 6 questions raised. In total, 53

different questions were raised by the assembly members of the Municipality of Klokot/Kllokot during this evaluation period, while such questions raised during this period were mainly of an infrastructural nature (roads, sewerage, sidewalks, lighting, etc.)

Regarding Indicator 3.2, namely ***“The number of contracts/projects in which the municipal assembly members are physically involved to oversee their implementation,”*** none of the members has been involved and as a result they have scored zero points in this indicator.

Recommendations

1. The assembly members of the municipalities of Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane, Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo, Istog/Istok and Klokot/Kllokot should commit to their representative role by organizing meetings with different citizen groups, including meetings with underrepresented groups.
2. The assembly members of the municipalities of Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane, Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo, Istog/Istok and Klokot/Kllokot should use communications and interactions through social media in order to commit to articulate issues/requests towards the executive and commit to ensure such solutions are created by municipal executives. With particular emphasis, this interaction and communication should be focused on underrepresented citizen groups.
3. The assembly members of the municipalities of Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane, Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo, Istog/Istok and Klokot/Kllokot should increase the legislative role, namely to commit to evaluate the policies sponsored by the municipal executive, as well as to commit to propose new policies.
4. The assembly members of the municipalities of Prizren, Gjilan/Gnjilane, Rahovec/Orahovac, Malishevë/Mališevo, Istog/Istok and Klokot/Kllokot should commit to oversee the implementation of contracts/projects. This commitment would increase the level of service provision to citizens in general.
